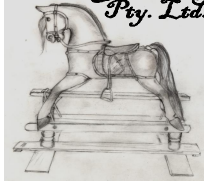

Dear Prospective Student,

We have worked hard to make real the dream of sharing our passion with others in relaxed and fun way at a beautiful location. We can think of no lovelier way to fill our lives for the next ten years or so than by sharing it with appreciative like-minded people.

Dates for your Class

The dates for 2007 dates are in the enclosed brochure. Please make a selection and write this on page 3 of this letter and on the Booking Sheet in the space provided. If after having booked one date, you find you need to change it, please call me immediately on (02) 4577-8697 and we will see what we can rearrange. Otherwise if all is fine, please jot it in both your diaries or calendars now. Class starts promptly at 9:00 am each day. Please be on time as art waits for no man or woman. Please note that the first day is the most physically demanding, and each successive day less so. It is important to be well rested and fresh for Friday especially if you are not used to standing and handling machinery for long periods. Please note that all tools and safety equipment are provided. Remember to bring a camera in order to document your success.

Accommodation in the Homestead: The Loft B & B of Rocking Horse Lodge is a Home/Farmstay in the main house, accommodates one couple and is available on a "first come, first served" basis. If this accommodation option is chosen I book you in for Friday and Saturday night only at this stage. Please consider if you need to book the Thursday night so as to be fresh for 9:00 am Friday or the Sunday night if you feel you would like to rest before venturing home and then indicate your preferences on the Booking Sheet enclosed.

Accommodation in Nearby B & B's Motels/Cabins: Brochures for the nearby motels/cabins are included in this booking pack. Please consider if you need to book the Thursday night so as to be fresh for 9:00 am Friday or the Sunday night if you feel you would like to rest before venturing home. Please book directly with them and mention you are doing the Rocking Horse Making Class at *Rocking Horse Lodge*. If you are bringing your own campervan, caravan or Winnebago, there is a fee of \$10 per night to connect to our conveniently located 15 amp point/water source and shower at the workshop. Please indicate same on the Booking Sheet.

A Word About Meals

Breakfasts :

If staying at the Loft's B & B a full cooked or continental breakfast either in bed, upstairs in your private dining nook or downstairs with the family and is included in the tariff. Please complete and return the breakfast menu with your preferences prior to retiring each night of your stay. Menu's are located in front of the folder in the room.. The motels offer a combination of full cooked or continental breakfasts at approximately \$10 to \$12 pp. Windsor Stables Cabin offers a self-cook breakfast basket for \$6 pp.

Lunches:

Rocking Horse Lodge offers a different BBQ lunch (1st Semester) or hearty winter fare (2nd Semester) each day for \$15.00 pp per day. Please indicate your interest on the Booking Sheet enclosed. You may also BYO lunch, but most students choose the fellowship and laughs of lunch together at the *Lodge*.

Dinners:

It is a 2 minute drive to the *Bird in Hand Bistro* in Pitt Town ; a 3-4 minute drive into Windsor. (See area map enclosed). Many of our couples get on so well they meet for dinner as a group at one of the restaurants around about. *The Loft* has a fridge, toaster, kettle & tea/coffee tray - if you prefer to BYO supplies for a light dinner.

Morning and Afternoon Teas/Wrap Party & Graduation are provided at no extra cost to students and their partners.

Cancellation

If you should need to cancel, a fee of 20% of the total booked value to *Renaissance Rocking Horses* applies, alternatively deposit monies may be applied to a later class or stay at *Rocking Horse Lodge B & B*. (Gift Certificates also available if you want to give a stay to someone special.)

Safety

Prior to commencement of the class, students can be provided an optional disposable overall (please indicate approx size on the booking sheet), to protect their skin and clothes and also a full length leather apron. During carving all students will need to wear the leather apron and a Triton Respirator which includes eye, ear and lung protection. At other times, when it is required, the students will have goggles and or hearing protection. All students are to wear closed toe shoes and old clothing. There are formal breaks at 10:30 am and 2:30 pm each day, but feel free to stop and sit when you need to, especially on the Friday. There is plenty of chilled water on hand to make sure you keep well hydrated while working.

Please note: There is no smoking permitted inside *The Lodge* or the Workshop at any time.

There is no consumption of alcohol permitted during the day & while using workshop equipment.

Amusements for the Ladies

Where the lady has not chosen to make a horse herself or does not wish to be directly involved in the carving, sanding or spraying on Friday or Saturday, there are a number of diversions available depending on your interests. These include but are not limited to a potter in Windsor or Richmond, doing your own hand or needlework, helping prepare morning/afternoon teas and lunches, talking, TV, reading & *good old nothing*. If you are interested in a braided rug or Victorian Crazy Patchwork Workshop, please advise.

Partners are not obliged to be at *the Lodge* during the classes. We do recommend you plan to be about on the Sunday for the Horse Fit out and Detailing, as ladies do add their special touch. If you are happy for hubby to go it alone, that's okay too. Viktoria will be running the Fit out and Detailing sections on Sunday.
